Institutional funding: Gold Open Access

- ETH Library covers APCs if
 - Article is published in a Gold OA journal of one of these publishers:

2021



How to proceed:

- Submit your manuscript with your ETH email address to the publisher
- Affiliation check
 - E-Mail domain
 - Author chooses
 - IP
 - ...
- The publisher sends the APC invoice directly to the library

Institutional funding: Read & Publish models

- ETH Library covers APCs for the following publishers

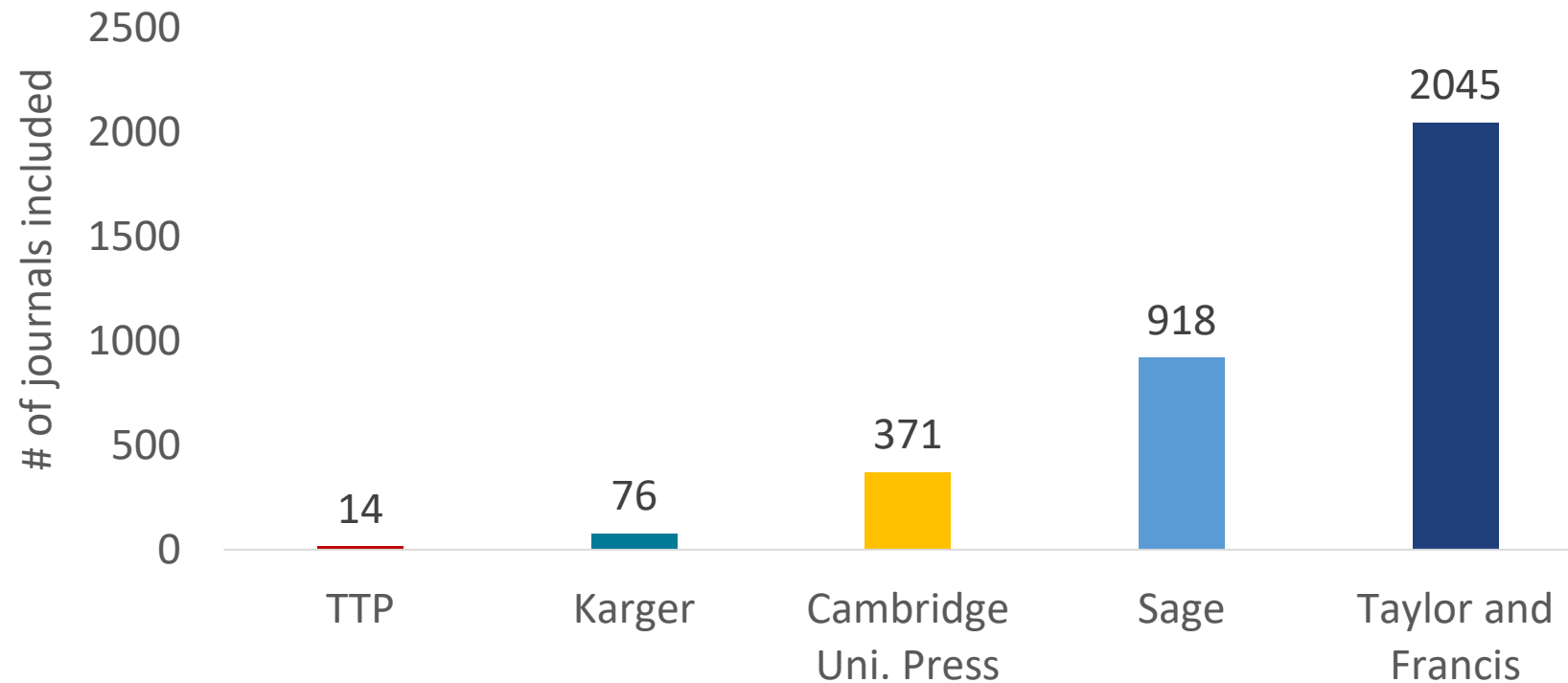


How to proceed:

- Submit your manuscript with your ETH email address to the publisher
- Affiliation check
 - E-Mail domain
 - Author chooses
 - IP
 - ...
- Library approves the article



- Journals included: Subscription (14)
- Deadline: Submission Date 2021
- Exception: -
- Article Types: all
- Workflow:
 - identify yourself as member of ETH Zurich during submission
 - choose open access

- Journals included: Subscription & Gold (76)
- Deadline: Submission Date 2021
- Exception: -
- Article Types: All
- [Workflow:](#)
 - Submission Process
 - Select Country
 - Select Institution
 - Choose «eligible»
 - Indicate your affiliation with ETH Zurich in the form

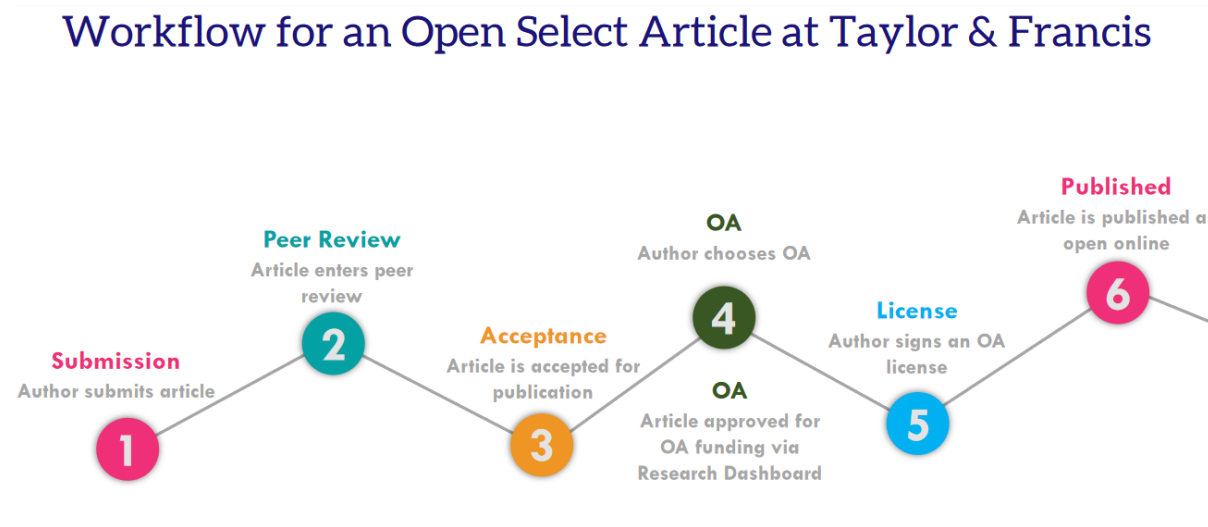

→ Choose ETH as payer!
 - Subscription journals: OA option is offered upon acceptance
→ Link in acceptance e-mail
→ Author chooses OA form

- Journals included: Subscription & Gold (918)
- Deadline: Submission Date 2021
- Exception: Journals without OA option at all
- Article Types: -
- Workflow: ETH members are recognized by their email domain and Ringgold ID
 - Use your institutional email address when submitting!
 - OA option is offered upon acceptance
 - Link in acceptance e-mail
 - Choose license

- Journals included: Subscription & Gold (2'045)
- Deadline: Acceptance Date 2021
- Exception: 32 Journals mainly «Expert Review of...» & «Expert Opinion on...» titles
- Article Types: • Article • Review • Research Article • Review Article • Report • Short Communication • Case Report • Note • Original Article • Guest Editorial
- Workflow: [Workflow for an Open Select Article at Taylor & Francis](#)



Last Step: Eligibility Check

ETH Library covers APCs if:

- **Submitting or corresponding author** must be a **member of ETH Zurich** → [Personal register](#)
- **Affiliation details** in the article must clearly **indicate the author's affiliation with ETH Zurich**.
- Institutional **e-mail address** (jane.doe@inst.ethz.ch) for submission.

Summary

- Workflows → Similar, but mind the differences
- Use institutional e-mail address whenever feasible
- Use «ETH Zurich» as affiliation information
