

## C. G. Jung scientific correspondence (Hs 1056)

### 1. Background

The scientific correspondence of the Swiss psychiatrist Carl Gustav Jung (1875-1961) is one of the largest private collections housed by the [ETH Zurich University Archives](#). The collection contains more than 32,000 units of description and covers the period from 1899 to 1961. The complete inventory with a detailed administrative history (in German only) is available [online in the ETH Zurich University Archives' database](#).

The entire collection of correspondence is divided into three parts:

- Incoming correspondence: letters, postcards etc. addressed to C. G. Jung
- Outgoing correspondence: letters, postcards etc. sent by Jung or his secretary
- Third party correspondence

### 2. Structure of data extract

These three parts are reflected in the data extract consisting of three CSV-files:

- ETHZ\_HSA\_Hs\_1056\_Jung\_corr\_incoming.csv (15,894 records)
- ETHZ\_HSA\_Hs\_1056\_Jung\_corr\_outgoing.csv (16,130 records)
- ETHZ\_HSA\_Hs\_1056\_Jung\_corr\_third\_party.csv (103 records)

The extract was produced in August 2017 on the basis of the descriptive metadata available online. All three files contain the same ISAD(G) data fields:
