- Registration process for newly admitted students

The Admissions Office cannot provide any counselling with regard to your chances of admission or pre-assessment of your application documents!

## **Application Dates - Autumn Semester 2023**

International Bachelor's degrees: 1 November - 15 December 2022, noon (11.59am, CET)

The following groups can **only** apply in this window:

- ALL students with a foreign Bachelor's degree
- Students who wish to apply for the Excellence & Opportunity Scholarship Programme (ESOP) or a Direct doctorate programme (DD)
- Students with a Master/PhD from a Swiss university who obtained their undergraduate degree outside Switzerland

Candidates with a Swiss Bachelor's degree can apply as well.

Swiss Bachelor's degrees: 1 April – 30 April 2023, noon (11.59am, CET)

Only for candidates who hold an undergraduate degree from a Swiss university.



Make sure to apply by the deadline of 15 December 2022 with all the required documents if you do not hold a Swiss Bachelor's degree. Applications in April from candidates holding a foreign degree will not be possible.



## **Master's Admission Prerequisites**

#### **Application Master**

ETH Zurich ranks as one of the top international universities in the technical and scientific disciplines. Depending on your educational background, there are different requirements for your application to our Master's degree programmes.

#### Formal prerequisites

- Degree from a university, recognised/accredited in the operating country
- Bachelor's degree equivalent in content, scope and quality to the one offered at ETH Zurich
- Language requirements fulfilled (English and/or German)

# **Master's Admission Prerequisites**

#### **Disciplinary prerequisites**

- Bachelor's degree in one of the qualifying disciplines specified by the respective Master's degree programme
- Please consult the requirement profile of the desired Master's degree programme: <u>www.ethz.ch/en/studies/master/application/profile-requirements</u>



In general: admission to our Master's degree programmes is very selective. We are looking for applications from excellent Bachelor graduates from universities comparable to ETH Zurich that meet the degree-specific requirement profiles. You have to check whether you are eligible for the desired programme before applying.

## Language requirements

- Majority of programmes are taught in English, some programmes require German proficiency
- The required Level is C1 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)
- List of recognised language certificates with minimum scores is published on our website, other certificates cannot be recognised
  - make sure that your language certificate is still valid by the time of application
- Exemptions are listed on our website



Test results must be available by the application deadline. Applications with invalid, insufficient, or missing language certificate will not be evaluated by the department and will be rejected on formal grounds.

## **Application documents**


#### **Required documents**

- General documents: i.e. CV, high school diploma, official transcript of records, diploma, language certificate, scan of passport
- Programme specific documents: i.e. course content form, GRE, internship confirmation
- Official translations by the university or translation agency required for all documents not issued in English, German, French or Italian
- Different requirements depending on your educational background, i.e. GRE scores, language requirements



Make sure to check the updated requirements for the coming application period on our website before applying!

## **Application process**





# How to apply? A short summary

- Check the deadlines: Application documents must be submitted by the application deadline, incomplete applications cannot be considered for evaluation
- Am I qualified for the Master's degree programme?
  - Do you satisfy the profile of requirements and other admission prerequisites?
  - Do you hold an undergraduate degree from a university accredited in the operating country?
- Do you have all required application documents for your desired programme?
  - programme-specific: GRE, course contents, letters of recommendation
- Prepare your documents: Make sure that the documents meet the standards: no self-attested transcripts!
- All information you submit must be true, complete and correct



We recommend you apply early! Make sure to prepare your documents in time. Do not wait until the last minute to upload your documents and to submit your application.
