

## Corona Safety Concept 529-0948-00P Solid State Chemistry

### Spring 2021

- The rules set by the Federal Office of Public Health (at least 1.5. m between individuals, thorough hand washing, getting tested in case of symptoms, etc.) must always be complied with as far as possible.
- It is compulsory to wear a disposable mask during the whole lab course. The attending students must bring their own masks.
- The masks must be changed latest after each afternoon or earlier when needed.
- It is compulsory to wash hands at the beginning of the lab course.
- The introductory question and answer sessions will be done at a large lecture hall room of appropriate size.
- Students are not allowed to be in the changing room (pre-room of lab course) before the lab is about to start.
- Students go directly to the assigned lab course rooms, arrive just in time, and get changed (do not leave the lab unless it is necessary).
- Students will be divided into groups of two persons each for the whole lab course. These groups will not meet each other in the lab rooms during the lab course.
- The laboratory course rooms all have sufficient size and ventilation to accommodate the 2-person group and one or two instructors/teaching assistants – no other individuals will be allowed in these labs while the practicum is running.
- Commonly used equipment will be disinfected after usage by a group.
- Handles on doors, cupboards and other surfaces should be regularly disinfected by students and teaching assistants throughout the lab course hours from 13.00-18.00 and always at the end of the lab day session.
- The data analysis and writing of student lab reports will be performed via video conference.
- In case a student/assistant is tested positive for Covid-19, or has symptoms, they must follow the ETH directions (email to: [infolehre@ethz.ch](mailto:infolehre@ethz.ch)) and immediately inform by email the lab course supervisor (Dr. M. Kotyrba, email: [kotyrba@inorg.chem.ethz.ch](mailto:kotyrba@inorg.chem.ethz.ch)).
- In case of quarantine or positive test of a group member: the schedule of the affected group will be changed to adjust for a later continuation of the lab work of the group – the course schedule has been adjusted to leave at least 2 extra weeks available to accommodate these changes.
