



Corona - precautionary measures at Monte Verità for CSF conferences

The organiser is responsible to inform the participants of the current security rules. We aim at creating a secure and fruitful environment for the CSF events, where an intensive personal exchange is possible, given the necessary need for distance.

General rule

We do not allow persons with COVID-19-symptoms or close contact with a COVID-19 patient within the last 14 days to travel to Monte Verità. Participants are obliged to follow the distance and hygiene regulations before and during the event.

Capacity of the conference venue

Restaurant: 64 person

Auditorium: 33 person

Sala Balint: 38 person (seated), for poster sessions the maximal occupancy is 14 people (please contact us for alternatives).

Bedrooms: there are 22 single rooms and 23 double rooms. Generally, we expect single occupancy, except for couples and if the participants do an approved self-test every day.

Coffee breaks

For the coffee breaks people must be seated. Please respect this in set-up of the timetable.

Protective masks

Wearing facemasks is mandatory for everyone participating in a CSF conference; please bring your own masks. Protective masks must also be worn in the restaurant until you actually sit down at a table.

Ventilation

The air-conditioning in the auditorium is running with maximal air extraction.

In the other meeting rooms, open the windows ten minutes every hour – please assign a responsible person.

Contact tracing

All participants must be registered with a valid email address and telephone number. Hand in the list to the CSF office before the arrival.

Additional remarks

If someone discovers symptoms during the stay at Monte Verità a test must be done immediately. If a participant is tested positive on Covid-19 a quarantine is necessary.

Individuals who become ill with COVID-19 immediately after the event are required to notify the event organizer and the CSF.

Please inform yourself about the current federal travel regulations.

Participants from countries with high risk ([current list](#)) need to go into a mandatory quarantine before participating a CSF conference.

The CSF plans their meetings on Monte Verità under the stated precautionary measures, based on the measures proposed from ETH Zürich. The uncertain situation however includes the possibility of short notice changes and additional restrictions. The rules given from the local authority (BAG and canton Ticino) apply at all times.

The instructions of the staff must be followed at all times.
