According to the Swiss Refugee Council, about 99,000 Ukrainians have found protection in Switzerland since February 2022. Due to the ongoing war in Ukraine, the Federal Council has twice extended the Temporary Protection Status S, which was originally limited to one year. For now, the Protection Status is expected to remain in force until March 2025. In the meantime, individuals in search of safety have found a home in Switzerland. They have friends, they work, their children go to school. What happens when the Temporary Protection Status expires? Together with Simone Zurschmitten, Head of the Resettlement Section SEM, and Babak Fargahi, Dr. iur. Attorney-at-Law RISE, we discuss the current situation and practical examples related to the Temporary Protection Status S in Switzerland.
