Compared to the first call, small changes are applicable to the max. funding:

• Support to travel cost is limited to a max. amount of CHF 500.

- Support for accommodation and daily allowance is limited to max. 10 days at a combined limit of CHF 250 per day.
- All expenses need to be justified by invoices. Only the expenses for the visitor can be refunded. The cost for persons accompanying the visitor cannot be refunded.


