# **ETH4D Faculty Exchange: Visiting Scientist Grants**

#### 1. Goal

ETH for Development (ETH4D) provides grants for visiting scientists, belonging to an academic institution in countries listed on the DAC-list of the OECD<sup>1</sup>. The visiting scientist may visit ETH Zurich to:

- 1. Conduct a **short research stay** at an ETH Zurich chair or laboratory.
- 2. To attend a conference or workshop organised by ETH Zurich scientists.

# 2. Eligibility and Partner Countries

Eligible to apply are ETH4D professors who are hired at ETH Zurich at least in a 50% position. ETH Zurich professors who are not yet a member of ETH4D can also apply and will become a member if they are awarded an ETH4D Visiting Scientist Grant.<sup>2</sup>

The visiting scientist must be affiliated at an institution in a country classified under the categories according to the DAC-list of the OECD. Preference will be given to "least developed"," low-income" and "lower-middle income" countries.

To be eligible, the invited candidate must fulfil the following requirements:

- Have a support letter from the hosting professor
- Proven academic qualifications

#### 3. Finances and Budget

A maximum of **10 kCHF** can be granted per visit. A detailed budget is requested, including financial contributions by the applicant, as well as the visiting scientist or their university (incash and/or in-kind).

# 4. Application and Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and the call remains open throughout the year. Submissions will be reviewed after the deadlines of 30 March and 15 October every year. Please complete the <u>electronic application form</u> and upload all required documents in a single PDF.

Please note that the following needs to be addressed in the project description (3000-6000 characters excl. space characters, timeframe, and work plan, using Arial/ size 11/ line pitch 1.15):

### **Research Stay**

- Project description and objectives to be achieved during the research stay.
- Timeframe and work plan.<sup>3</sup>
- Description of:
  - added value of conducting research at ETH Zurich for individual career development of visiting scientist.
  - how the acquired knowledge might be used in the context of visiting scientist's research and dissemination at home institution.
  - interest of hosting professor to host this scientist, including potential follow-up activities after the stay.

# **Conference / Workshop attendance**

- Expected benefit for the institutional relationship between ETH Zurich and the candidate's institution.
- Relevance of the conference or workshop for the candidate's research and career development.
- Timeframe and work plan.<sup>3</sup>

<sup>3</sup> For visiting scientists traveling by plane, applications with a proposed stay of five or more nights in Switzerland will be prioritized, including for conference- or workshop-based stays.

#### 5. Selection

All applications are reviewed by the ETH4D Committee for Exchanges and Scholarship. The notification letter will be sent to the applicant within two months of the submission deadline.

## 6. Reporting

After the completion of the project, the applicant must submit two final reports to ETH4D:

### 6.1. Operational report

One page describing the visit, lessons learned, problems encountered and planned follow-up activities (with a focus on individual and institutional capacity development). A template for the report will be provided by the ETH4D grants office after the stay.

### 6.2. Financial report

All expenses must be listed and documented with receipts.
