ETH4D Research to Action Grants

Evaluation Criteria:

Criterion 1: Global Development Impact
--

Sub-criterion 1

Results are being used, implemented, or disseminated demonstrating a global development related impact

Sub-criterion 2

Preference will be given to activities in countries listed as "least developed, low- and lower-middle-income country"

In exceptional cases: can projects be disseminated in higher-income countries as long as they have a clear and direct global development-related impact

Criterion 2: Researcher has an Institutional Link to ETH Zurich

Sub-criterion 1

e.g., previous research or courses taken at ETH or an affiliation with ETH initiatives which promote the development of innovative solutions

Criterion 3: Project is Bridging the Gap between Research and Practice

Sub-criterion 1

The project proposal clearly states how research results are put into practice

Criterion 4: Clear Project Deliverables

Sub-criterion 1 – If dissemination:

1.1 The project has a defined and justified target audience

1.2 The project entails clear key messages for participants to take away

Sub-criterion 2 – If prototype:

2.1 The project proposal indicates a clear purpose of the prototype (Will the product work? Is it realistic? Is it useful? Does it meet a current need?)

Criterion 5: Realistic Timeframe and Work-Plan

Sub-criterion 1

The planned timeframe and workplan are feasible and align with the activities

Criterion 6: Realistic budget

Sub-criterion 1

The planned budget is realistic and mirrors the activities

Criterion 7: Convincing partnership (if applicable)

Sub-criterion 1

The partner's expertise/ thematic focus aligns with the project's content
