ETH4D Faculty Exchange: Visiting Scientist Grants

1. Goal

ETH for Development (ETH4D) provides grants for visiting scientists, belonging to an academic institution in countries listed on the <u>OECD/DAC list 2018-2020</u>¹. The visiting scientist may visit ETH Zurich to:

- 1. Conduct a **short research stay** at an ETH Zurich chair or laboratory.
- 2. To attend a conference or workshop organised by ETH Zurich scientists.

2. Eligibility and Partner Countries

Eligible to apply are ETH4D members (senior scientists belonging to an ETH4D member group are eligible as well) that are hired at ETH at least in a 50 % position. ETH Zurich scientists, which are not yet a member of ETH4D, can also apply and will become a member if they are awarded an ETH4D Visiting Scientist Grant.²

The visiting scientist must be affiliated at an institution in a country classified under the categories according to the <u>OECD/DAC list 2018-2020</u>. Preference will be given to low and lower-middle income countries.

To be eligible, the invited candidate has to fulfil the following requirements:

3. Finances and Budget

A maximum of **10 kCHF** can be granted per visit. A detailed statement of the funds required and all funding sources should be included, as well as a presentation of the applicant's and partners' contribution to the costs (financial and/or in-kind).

4. Application and Deadline

Deadline for the next round of applications is **30 November 2020.** Applications can only be accepted submitted through <u>the online portal</u>.

5. Selection

All applications are reviewed by the ETH4D Committee for Exchanges. The notification letter will be sent to the applicant within two months of the submission deadline.

6. Reporting

After the completion of the project, the applicant has to submit two final reports to ETH4D:

6.1. Technical report

One page describing the visit, lessons learned, problems encountered and planned follow-up activities (with a focus on individual and institutional capacity development).

6.2. Financial report

All expenses have to be listed and documented with receipts.
