



Terms and conditions

for the photo competition 'KEEP IT CO₂OL' on CO₂ and climate change by focusTerra, ETH Zurich

- o The competition runs until 15 November 2024.
- Participation is free of charge.
- All persons residing in Switzerland are eligible to participate. Minors must be given permission by a parent or guardian (<u>consent form</u>) before taking part in the competition.
- o Participants can enter the competition as many times as they wish.
- Submissions will only be accepted via upload on the website focusterra.ethz.ch/keep-it-cool.
- An internal focusTerra jury will select 12 winners. The winners and all other persons whose submissions are used in the exhibition will be notified in writing.
- The jury's decisions are final and indisputable. The prizes of the 12 winners cannot be exchanged for others or paid out in cash.
- Motifs with pornographic, child-endangering, nationalistic, racist, violenceglorifying, offensive or otherwise illegal or offensive content will be deleted and excluded from the competition. *focus*Terra reserves the right to judge this at its own discretion and to exclude individual entries or participants from the competition accordingly.
- Please note that brands, trademarks and works of third parties may be legally protected and may not be published or depicted without the consent of the authorised parties (e.g., Eiffel Tower at night).
- O By entering the competition, participants confirm that they have taken the photo and written the story themselves and are therefore author of the submitted content and have unrestricted rights of use. They also confirm that the submitted photo does not infringe the rights of third parties. Persons who can be recognised in the photo must have agreed to the publication and use of the photo by focusTerra. The submitters or their legal guardians are themselves fully liable if any claims are made due to image rights (warnings, lawsuits, etc.).
- By participating in the competition, participants grant focusTerra the right to freely make use of the submitted materials for its own purposes. This includes the publication of the photo, personal story, title, first name, age and place where the photo was taken in the exhibition as well as on websites, other platforms, social media channels of ETH Zurich and exhibition venues





where the exhibition will be shown at a later date (in Switzerland or abroad), as well as in the exhibition publication and on posters and brochures for science communication and advertising purposes for the exhibition. This use is made without any remuneration being owed to the participants (unlimited right of use and exploitation, both in terms of time and place).

- Participants agree that focus Terra may slightly adapt the personal story
 (e.g. to correct spelling mistakes or condense the texts) provided that the
 content remains unchanged. The personal details collected, apart from the first
 name, age and the place where the photo was taken, will not be passed on to
 third parties.
- No correspondence will be conducted regarding the competition. There is no recourse to legal action.
- Participants who violate these terms and conditions will be disqualified from the competition.
