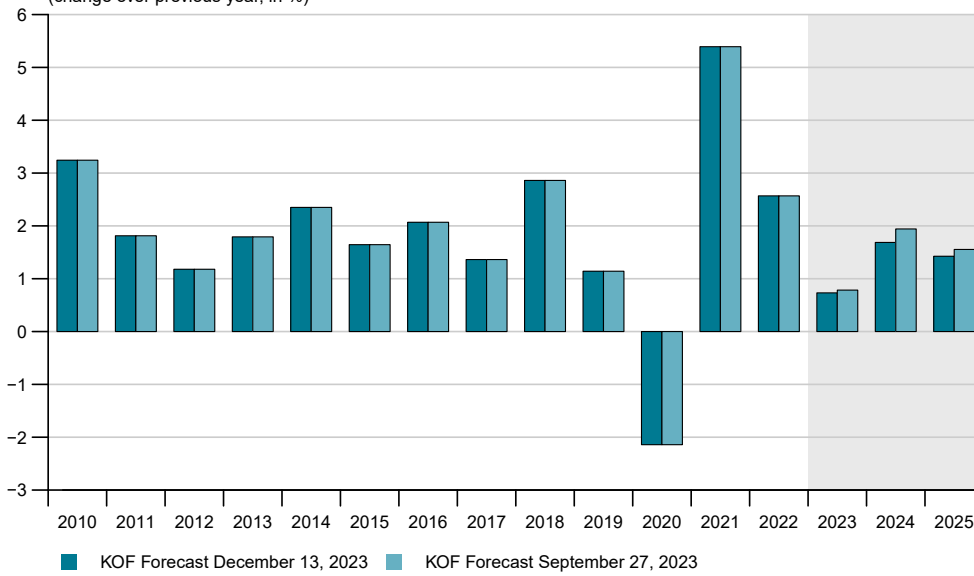

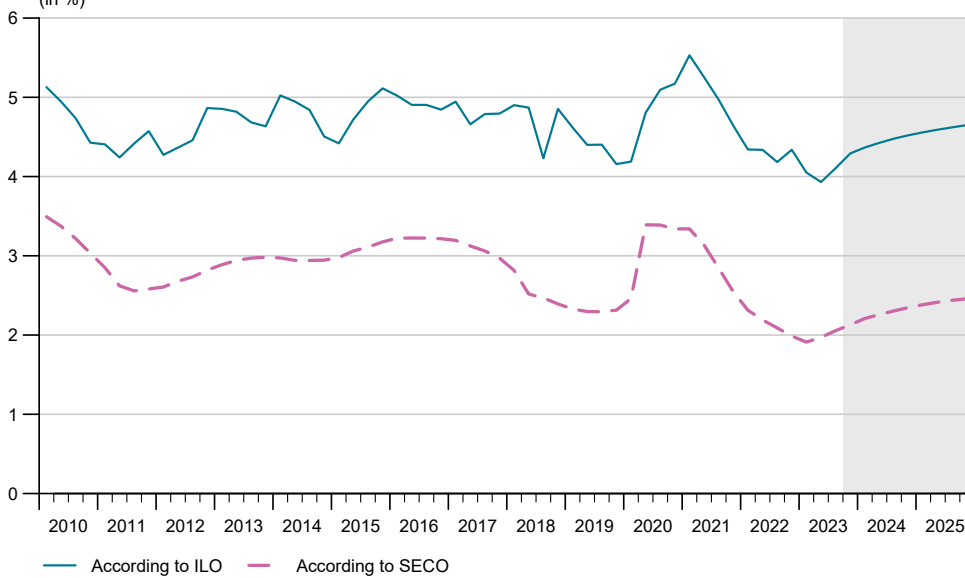

(change over previous year, in %)

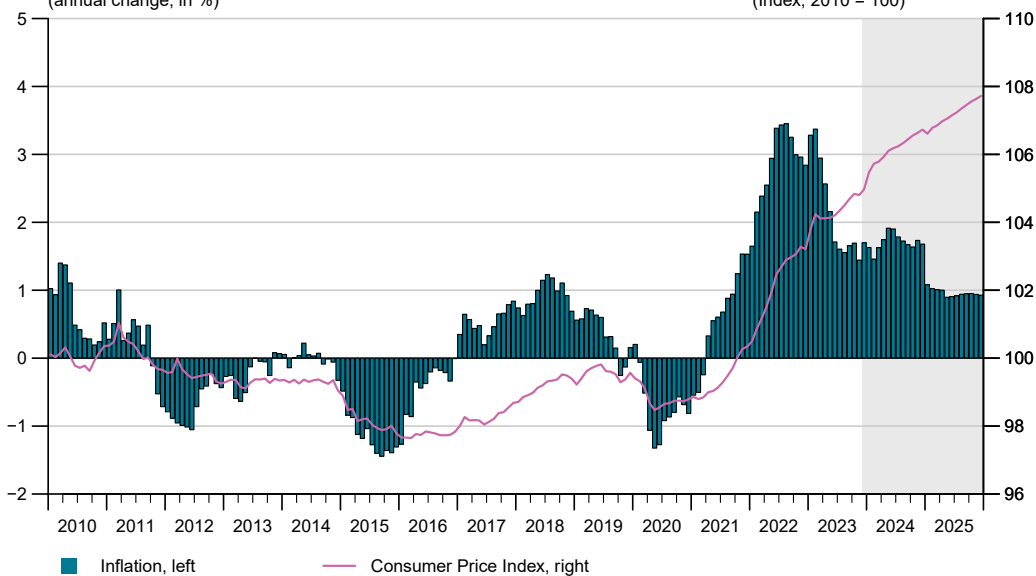


Unemployment Rate
(in %)

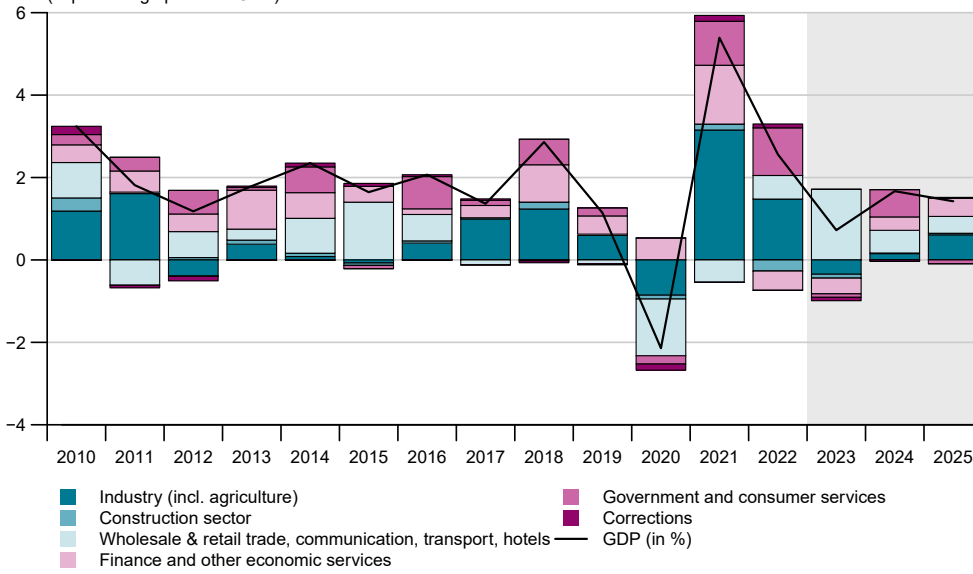


Consumer Prices
(annual change, in %)

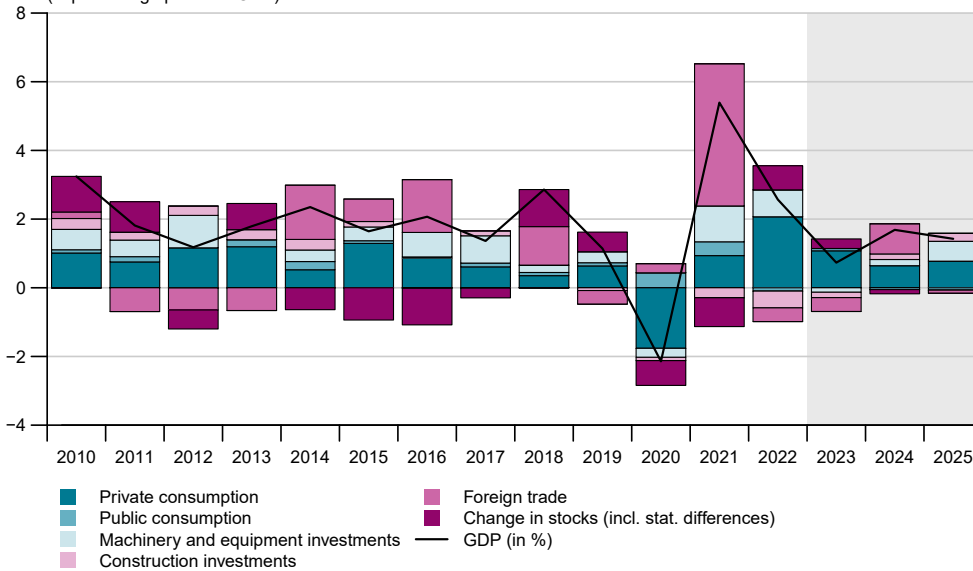
