

LELAM-TVET4INCOME - An r4d Research Project NEWSLETTER – FEBRUARY 2019



The LELAM-TVET4 INCOME research project is part of the Swiss Programme for Research on Global Issues for Development (r4d). It aims to understand under what conditions TVET (Technical Vocational Education and Training) can improve the income of the youth in Benin, Chile, Costa Rica and Nepal.

PAST EVENTS

In January 2018, the steering committee of the R4D project held a Steering Committee Meeting in Costa Rica, helping to learn about the Costa Rican TVET situation.



From May 28, 2018 to June 7, 2018, we had a PhD Workshop. The Swiss partners of the LELAMTVET4Income project invited all five PhD students of the project and the researcher from Costa Rica to attend a two-week workshop on TVET and methods in Zurich.

August 2018: Inauguration of the Master in Technical and Vocational Education and Training (MTVET) at Kathmandu University (KU) School of Education (KUSOED). The development and introduction of the MTVET is financed through the LELAM-TVET4Income Project.



October 6-12 of 2018, the LELAM-TVET4Income project team had a Scientific mission to Benin, with the aim to know the Beninese Technical Vocational Education (TVET) system and its stakeholders. During the visit, the team was invited to join a debate about dual TVET in Beninese television.
