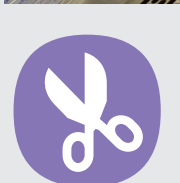
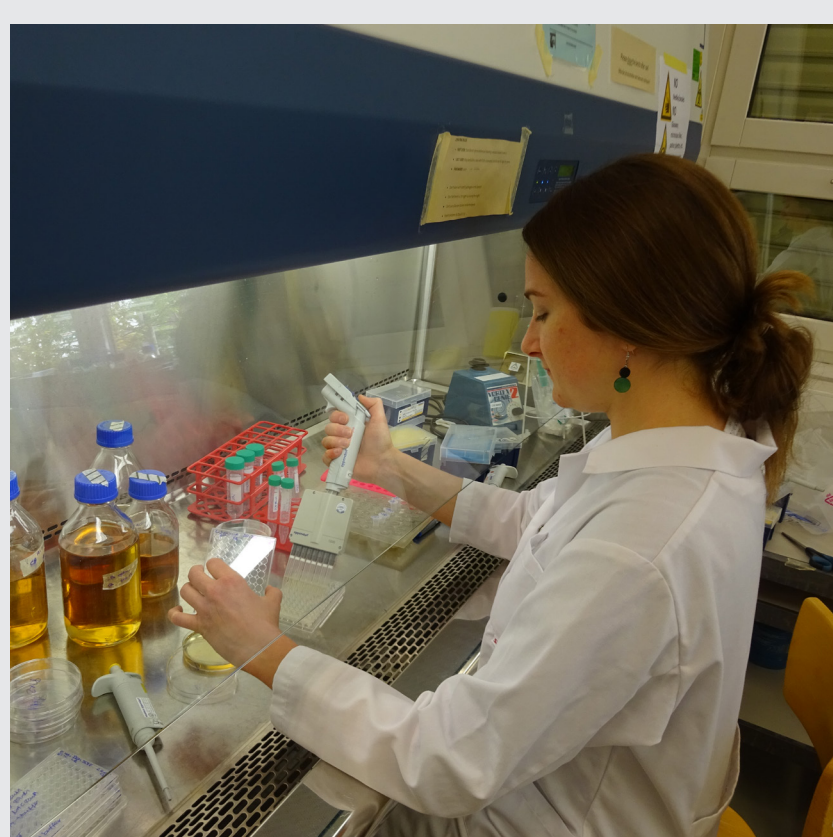
The World Food System Center

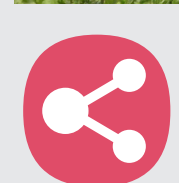

Core Activities



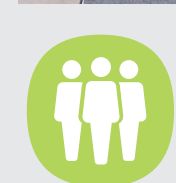
Research
