2 Results




Agricultural Policy Responses:

- Minimization of bureaucratic procedures for agribusiness ٠
- ٠ Permission to use agricultural machinery without registration
- Simplification of the import of seeds ٠
- The introduction of zero rate of excise tax
- State programs: affordable loans, grant support for processing companies
- Initiation of the online platform State Agricultural Register
- To offer alternative logistic networks for exports because of the blockade of ports
