Rapid expansions in AI technologies and data availability are transforming the economy while providing new tools for economic analysis. The **3rd Zurich Workshop in AI+Economics** brings together economists interested in (1) adapting AI tools – e.g. machine learning, natural language processing, computer vision — in empirical economics, or (2) empirical economic analysis of AI technologies. The workshop provides an opportunity for discussion and feedback on frontier works at this intersection of fields. <u>Here is the program from last year's edition</u>.

The workshop will be held in person in Zürich, Switzerland, on December 6-7, 2024. <u>Melissa Dell</u>, from Harvard University, will give the keynote. Participation is free, and funding is available for travel and accommodation expenses. Coffee and meals will be provided.
