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Detailed Regulations of D-HEST for the expenses of external lecturers

The Department of Health Sciences and Technology decrees in addition to Art. 7 Abs. 2 lit. i of the D-HEST Rules of Procedure, the following detailed regulations regarding the reimbursement of expenses to external lecturers for courses of the study programmes of D-HEST:

- 1. Expenses for travel, meals and accommodation in connection with ETH Zurich lectures are borne principally by the external lecturer.
- 2. On application by the mentor, in substantiated exceptional cases, the Department can reimburse part of the expenses up to a specified maximum limit.
- 3. As a general rule, the following criteria must be fulfilled for consideration by the Director of Studies:
 - a) Course is part of the study programme of the Department (not counting continuing education);
 - b) Main responsibility for the course;
 - c) At least a 50% participation in the course;
 - d) Application from the mentor justifying the need and importance of the lecturer for the course.
- 4. The application must be submitted at least one month before the start of the semester to the attention of the responsible Director of Studies.
- 5. The Department reimburses a maximum of half the incurred expenses for travel, meals and accommodation, but only to the limit of CHF 500 per semester.
- 6. The Rules of Procedure of the ETH Zurich governing occupational expenses¹ apply.
- 7. The decision of the Director of Studies is final.
