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Detailed Regulations of D-HEST on the promotion of associate professors

The Department of Health Sciences and Technology decrees, in addition to Art. 14 Abs 1 lit. b of the D-HEST by-laws, the following detailed regulations concerning the promotion of associate professors:

- 1. The instructions of the President apply (<u>Link</u>).
- 2. The application procedure for promotion begins with an application from the associate professor to the attention of the Department Head.
- 3. The applicant submits the following documents for the attention of the Department Head:
 - a. Documents according to point 1;
 - b. Electronic versions (PDF) of the three to six most important publications;
 - c. A list of six external experts, who are prepared to write a letter of reference.
- After receipt of the full documentation according to point 3, the Department Head calls for a first conference of full professors (KoP). This conference decides on the commencement of the promotion procedure.
- 5. If the KoP accept the application of the associate professor, the members of the KoP choose full professors closely related to the specialized area of the applicant to form a Promotion Preparation Committee, PPC, including a chairperson.
- 6. The duties of the PPC under the responsibility of the Chairman are:
 - a. The gathering of at least 6 reference letters from (external) internationally renowned experts;
 - b. From the collected expert opinions only three can come from the applicant's list. The experts receive all documents pertaining to the applicant;
 - c. Compilation of an evaluation report for the attention of the Department Head;
 - d. The PPC treats all documents confidentially.
- 7. If the PPC recommends the promotion application in their evaluation report, the Department Head requests a second KoP.
- 8. The second KoP decides whether the application for promotion should be submitted to the President.
- The Department Head writes an application with the reasons given by the Department and submits it with all documentation.
- 10. After the election by the ETH Board the Department Head informs the Professors and Department Conference.
