Detailed Regulations for the employment of Doctoral Students in D-HEST

The Department of Health Sciences and Technology decrees with regard to Art. 10 Abs. 1 of the Ordinance on the regulations governing scientific personnel of the Federal Institute of Technology Zurich, as well as Art. 7 Abs. 2 lit. i of the bylaws of D-HEST, the following detailed regulations regarding the employment of doctoral students:

- 1. The Ordinance governing the scientific personnel of the Federal Institute of Technology Zurich (SR 172.220.113.11) applies.
- 2. Doctoral students work a minimum of 70 percent of their working time on their dissertation and its underlying research, and for their doctoral studies.
- 3. They work on teaching tasks and general duties. Exceptions are special agreements with third party funders.
- 4. In D-HEST, each professor decides according to the context of points 1-3 on the deployment and remuneration of doctoral students.
