#### R Robert Gnehm Grant

Since 2016, ETH has offered financial support for 10–15 doctoral or postdoctoral researchers per year. Doctoral students and postdocs with small children or children in school age are awarded a grant in case they present their research results at an important conference or go on a short research stay abroad. For administrative and technical staff business trips/further education are sometimes necessary. Additional costs for extraordinary childcare may occur as well.
