# Presentation

1. **Context:** what is the setting/problem, how previous solutions fail?
2. **Main ideas:** what are the proposed main ideas?
3. **Technical details:** some details, evaluation and results – but not all!
4. **Your opinions and critique:** novelty, practicality, impact, ...
