Dear Doctoral Student, dear Doctoral Thesis Supervisor

The purpose of this document is to guide you through the annual status conversation.

It consists of 2 separate parts.

In the first part, you will talk about the research project, its status and next steps. Here, it might be beneficial to include the second advisor. Basis for this part is the progress report.

The second part should be solely between the doctoral student and the doctoral thesis supervisor. There you should give bi-directional feedback, talk about general working conditions and development potentialities. The annual status conversation is sent to the second advisor for information.
