





Getting started

- Lectures started yesterday
 - Find info on where and when in the course catalogue and MyStudies
- Use the first two weeks to see if your chosen courses fit Change if necessary
 - The Student Exchange Office will ask you to update your study plan
 - Also update your choice on MyStudies
 - If a course has an enrolment restriction, try contacting the lecturer(s). If they agree, our Study Administration can do the enrolment for you.
 - If you need advice, feel free to contact me any time!
- Don't forget to register for exams
 - You can deregister until very late without consequences by ETH

Exams and Credit Transfer

- Exams will take place at the end of the semester or in the exam session.
 - The exam mode is described in MyStudies and in the course catalogue
 - If you need to pre-/postpone your exam or require a distance examination, set this up soon!
- When the exam session is over, our Study Administration will automatically send your academic transcript to the address you provided in MyStudies
 - The Student Exchange Office says you have to request your transcript. Not at D-MATH, we do that in all cases!
 - Make sure your postal address is up to date.
