True to our mantra that "seeing is believing," we will now do our best to offer you these firsthand impressions and discussions with Swiss experts and apprentices virtually.

Content of Virtual Institute Part 2

We will concentrate our content in two weeks of daily live events on Zoom. Every weekday in the weeks of **February 1-5 and 8-12, 2021**, we will have one live event at 15:00 CET. We will also conduct your **final case workshops** during this two-week period.

The live events will be lectures, keynotes, Q&A sessions, and panel discussions with apprentices. You will have the opportunity to personally ask questions of apprentices, successful practitioners, and leading researchers. For those with scheduling conflicts, these will also be recorded and posted on Moodle. We will close the virtual interaction of the institute on Friday, February 12, with a final full-group discussion. In addition to these live sessions, we will offer a plethora of virtual content on Moodle, which you can view anytime until May 31, 2021. These activities include apprenticeship vlogs, keynotes, and video site visits to Swiss training companies and facilities.


Case Implementation Workshop and Feedback Report

One of the most valuable components of the virtual institute is the **case implementation workshop**. This final workshop is intended to ensure your team is set on the right track.

We invite you to prepare a short presentation (15-20 minutes) on the progress you have made since the beginning of the institute and the steps you plan to

take next. The CEMETS team will give you further feedback. Workshops last 45 minutes in total. Three months after the final event (no later than **May 31, 2021**), you will send us your **final report**. The aim is to show how your progress in implementing your final plan. The CEMETS team will send **final written feedback** on month after you submit your final report. Members of teams who submit the report will receive a certificate of completion.
