

How to register for a simulation as a student:

Once the simulation has been created within a course, you will be sent a course link to your course. The course URL will look similar to this: <http://cb.hbsp.harvard.edu/cb/access/6385986#>. The numbers at the end of this link are the specific identifier for this unique course.

Once you have accessed the link, you will navigate to this screen. If you have never registered on our educator's site, please click on "Register Now". If you have already registered as a student when accessing a prior course on our site, please login with your login credentials at "Login Now".






