Prof. Johan Stahre is an expert in the fields of industrial digitalisation, automation, and the human role in the future of manufacturing. He heads the Division of Production Systems at Chalmers University of Technology and he is co-director of the Swedish national strategic innovation program “Produktion2030”. Professor Stahre has also been operational in establishing the pan-European innovation and education program, EIT Manufacturing. All these initiatives drive digital transformation of European production.

Digital Transformation in Challenging Times

The impact of COVID-19 greatly accelerates the ongoing transformation of industry and society. Digitalisation and technologies like the internet, robots, and AI are rapidly enabling the change.
