In this practical workshop, participants learn to create a captivating story from their doctoral topic. In addition, the basics of performance skills, such as voice and non-verbal communication, are trained. Every form of communication is dialogic - even a pitch with 100% speaking presence. By noticing triggers in the audience, workshop participants learn to communicate in a way that is appropriate to the addressee. In practical exercises, participants experience sudden insights by comparing their own with the perception of others. Structured feedback loops allow them to build on strengths and work on blind spots.
