




2019 MAS & CAS Participants – Personal Background








2019 MAS & CAS Participants – Academic Background




2019 MAS & CAS Participant Profile – Industry

MAS AT Rolling Admission - All Year

CAS AIT January 1 – May 31

CAS AMT June 1 – November 30

CAS ATE September 1 – February 28

- MAS AT applications received by May 31 have priority over CAS only applications and later MAS applications for starting in September




Supporting Documents

- Degree certificate and final academic record
- Job References
- Identity Documentation
- Employer Recommendation Letter Suggested
- Work History (in application form) or CV Suggested



MAS AT Application Review



Initial Screening of Applications

- Application is complete
- Satisfy Minimum Criteria
 - ✓ Education
 - Special case, e.g. Bachelor's degree
 - ✓ Managerial Experience
 - ✓ Knowledge of English language

Programme Review & Selection of Applications

- Good Fit: Participant Programme
 - ✓ Match target profile or equivalent fit
- Likely to Successfully Complete Programme
 - ✓ Look at complete dossier: Experience, Training, etc.
- Career Potential
 - ✓ Career to date & Employer recommendation
- General Balance
 - ✓ Goal rich peer learning experience, network opportunities.

Admission Decision

- Notified by letter from SCE
- Typically in June or July
- No need to confirm your participation
- Withdrawal: written notification by date in SCE letter
- Late withdrawal is subject to a fee



Fees

- Application
 - 50 CHF (applicants with a Swiss degree)
 - 150 CHF (applicants from other universities)
- Tuition
 - MAS: 39'000 CHF
 - CAS: 8'500 CHF
 - Books & materials not included
