

MAS MTEC Anti-plagiarism information sheet

This information sheet provides an overview about some important aspects that MAS MTEC students have to consider in the context of avoiding plagiarism in their Master's thesis.

1. Registration requirements for the Master's thesis

1.1 "Citation etiquette" - Plagiarism Information Sheet by ETH Zurich

Before you can register for the Master's thesis you must have read the "[Citation etiquette](#)" information sheet on plagiarism defined by ETH Zurich.

1.2 Preparation course

- You must have passed the [Epigeum's Avoiding Plagiarism Online Course](#) which covers anti-plagiarism topics and citation rules in the first semester of your studies
- Students have to confirm the successful completion of this course during the registration process for the Master's thesis in myStudies.

2. Submission of the Master's thesis

- A signed [Declaration of Originality](#) has to be handed in with the Master's thesis.
- Without this Declaration of Originality the Master's thesis will not be accepted.
