> Cristian is a former Global Head Learning & Development at General Electric and former Global Head Operational Quality & Continuous Improvement at Alstom. He was named the "Operational Excellence European Contributor of the Year" in 2011 and in 2019 won with Veolia the Process Excellence Award for the "Best Business Transformation Project in the World". In 2020 Cristian co-authored "DARE! – behind the scenes of the best Business Transformation Project in the World". In his talk he will focus on the holistic view on Change Management, covering the following three main topics: (i) Transforming crisis in opportunities (ii) An integrated view of the challenges posed by developing 21st Century-types Organizational Architectures while introducing Advanced Technologies (iii) how to transform these challenges in opportunities for Human Capital Development.

He will also share the key success factors of impactful change to generate better change outcomes and improve financial performance.

In March 2020, the Corona Pandemic changed the lives of most people. This health crisis has been one of the biggest challenges for hospitals and doctors in their lives. Within a very short period of time, a system geared mostly to efficiency and economization had to be prepared for this emergency. Even though many doctors did not experience a real disaster in the end, hospitals had to implement a real change management over the last months. This talk will address, what has worked, what can we learn and what are the next steps with Covid 19 in the health care system? Sharing these experiences and take always will put the theoretical concept of change management into perspective.
