

## **Hints for the production of the game materials for the role-playing game on palm oil**

### **Children**

The children are made of modelling clay (FIMO). Instead of self-made figures, stones or wooden tiles can also be used as tokens.

### **Contracts**

The template is designed for one-sided A4 printing. In order to be able to use them several times, they have been laminated. Matted laminating foil (125micron) has proved its worth.

### **Player cards**

This template is also suitable for one-sided A4 printing. After printing it must be halved with the target format A5. This card is also intended for multiple use and should be laminated (125micron).

### **Money**

The money should be printed on both sides. Please make sure that the edges of the money are printed on top of each other as far as possible so that there is no excessive deviation when cutting. The following settings have proved successful: two-sided, short edge, actual size. In order to be able to recognize the different amounts of money easily, one can print the different values on differently coloured paper.

Alternatively, you can simply buy play money and use it. However, you should keep in mind that when you buy play money, a local currency is often displayed and the palm oil game does not necessarily take place in any specific country.

### **Tax sheets**

These are intended for single use. The print format here is also A4. There are three control sheets per A4 printout. So for 3 game passes. The exception is the control sheet for the industrial mill. There is a simple and an advanced version. The advanced version is a single A4 per games session.
