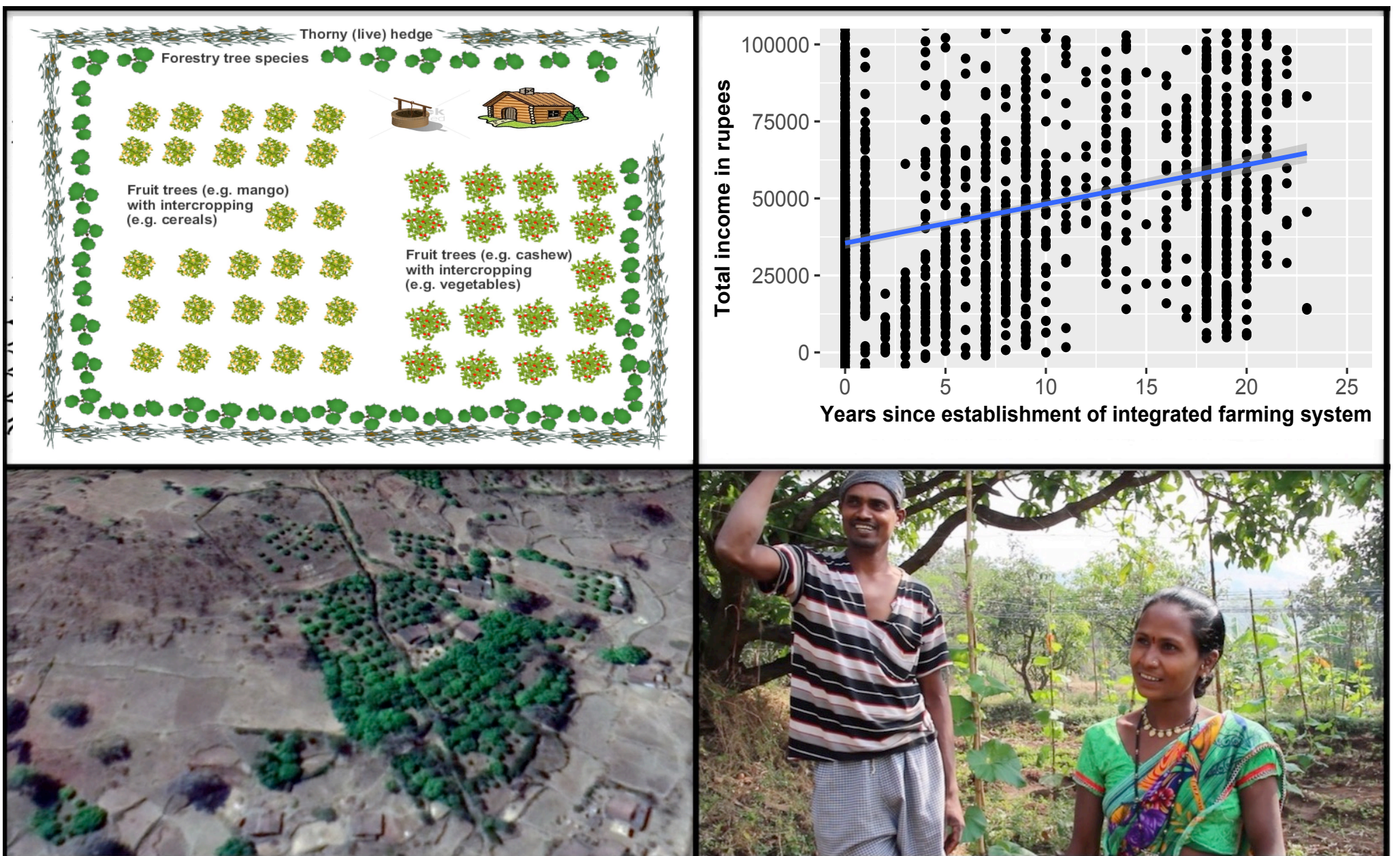


Development pathways out of poverty

- Can integrated farming systems transform places of seasonal migration?
- Through a household survey (n=2000) and qualitative research, we found that this integrated farming system:
 - increases **income**, breaking a vicious cycle of **poverty** and **seasonal distress migration**, thus enabling families to provide their children with **education** and better **perspectives**
 - improves **climate resilience** through **water resource development**, **diversification** and **tree based farming**
 - empowers participants to invest in their own land and to adopt **new technologies**
