HELVETAS Mozambique is currently implementing two interrelated Swiss Development Cooperation (SDC) funded Water Projects (PROGOAS & WIP) with the combined goal to enhance good governance in the provision of services in the Water Sector. The PROGOAS project is implemented since 2009 in the provinces of Nampula and Cabo Delgado. The WIP started in 2012 and is mainly implemented at national level through the office in Maputo with strong evidence gathering in the referred two provinces in order to inform the advocacy and policy dialogue at national level. The interventions of the two projects are planned and carried out together with local governments and communities, and at national level with coalition partners and strategic linkages with parliamentary related institutions and audit supreme institutions.

MAIN TASKS

- Identify, document and capitalize PROGOAS & WIP best practices, testimonies, stories of change, etc.
- Contribute to innovative development of social accountability methodologies and tools such as public hearings, public expenditure tracking, social audits
- Co-organize and document experience sharing events with partners and sector stakeholders
- Create and moderate a virtual platform and Community of Practice for CSO partners of PROGOAS and WIP
- Identify key messages and co-produce policy briefs, fact sheets, concept notes and video clips as defined in the projects' annual plan that feed into ongoing policy and advocacy efforts
- Consult and liaise with key Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) stakeholders in order to exchange information and strengthen collaboration
- Explore potential for partnerships with additional stakeholders ranging from the private sector companies to alliances with WASH sector actors (scoping)

- Bachelor's or Master's Degree in Political Science or a similar discipline relevant to the topic and/or to development cooperation
- First relevant working experience and a good understanding for the development context would be preferred
- A strong sense of team spirit, strong communication and interpersonal skills combined with a high degree of cultural sensitivity
- A high degree of self-dependence and the willingness to travel frequently within Mozambique
- Excellent spoken and written English, knowledge of Portuguese or Spanish preferred.
